
About Us



Mohammad Rizwan's experience as a caregiver to his wife, Sana Rizwan, shines a light on the many emotional, financial, and physical challenges that families face when dealing with a serious illness. In 2021, Sana was diagnosed with Stage IV non-small-cell lung cancer, a diagnosis that came after months of unexplained leg pain. Rizwan's persistence in seeking further medical attention, including urging for an X-ray review, ultimately led to the discovery of the cancer, which had otherwise been missed in earlier examinations.




