
About Us



VILAS KHADE-AKOLA, MAHARASHTRA

In November 2022, my life was shattered by an advanced-stage esophageal cancer diagnosis-CT⁴N². The tumor was large, measuring 9 cm by 3 cm, and had already spread to my lymph nodes. Hearing those words from the doctor felt like the earth had swallowed me whole. It was a devastating moment, but in the very same instant, I made a vow: I wasn't going to give up. I started my treatment at NCI Nagpur, where I underwent 14 chemotherapy cycles and 33 radiation sessions. Every day felt like an unrelenting battle-physically, emotionally, and mentally. The side effects of treatment drained me, leaving me feeling weak and uncertain at times.






Survivor Speaks
