






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## <u>Patient/Caregiver Corner</u>

Rushikesh Jayale, from Yavatmal,
Maharashtra, was living his dream life
when his world was shattered by a
devastating diagnosis: lung cancer.
"It was a shock," Rushikesh recalls. "I was
so young, and I had never smoked a day
in my life."

The symptoms crept up on him gradually
- persistent coughing, blood in his
sputum, and a growing sense of
weakness. When the tests confirmed his
worst fears, Rushikesh felt like his world
was crumbling around him.
