- Lung cancer is a major public health problem in both developed and developing countries
- Common psychosocial issues in lung cancer are uncertainty, fear, anxiety, depression, stigma
- Integrating mental health resources into cancer care settings facilitates early identification and intervention for individuals with psychological distress
- Evidence based psychological intervention helps patient to cope effectively and enhance QOL
